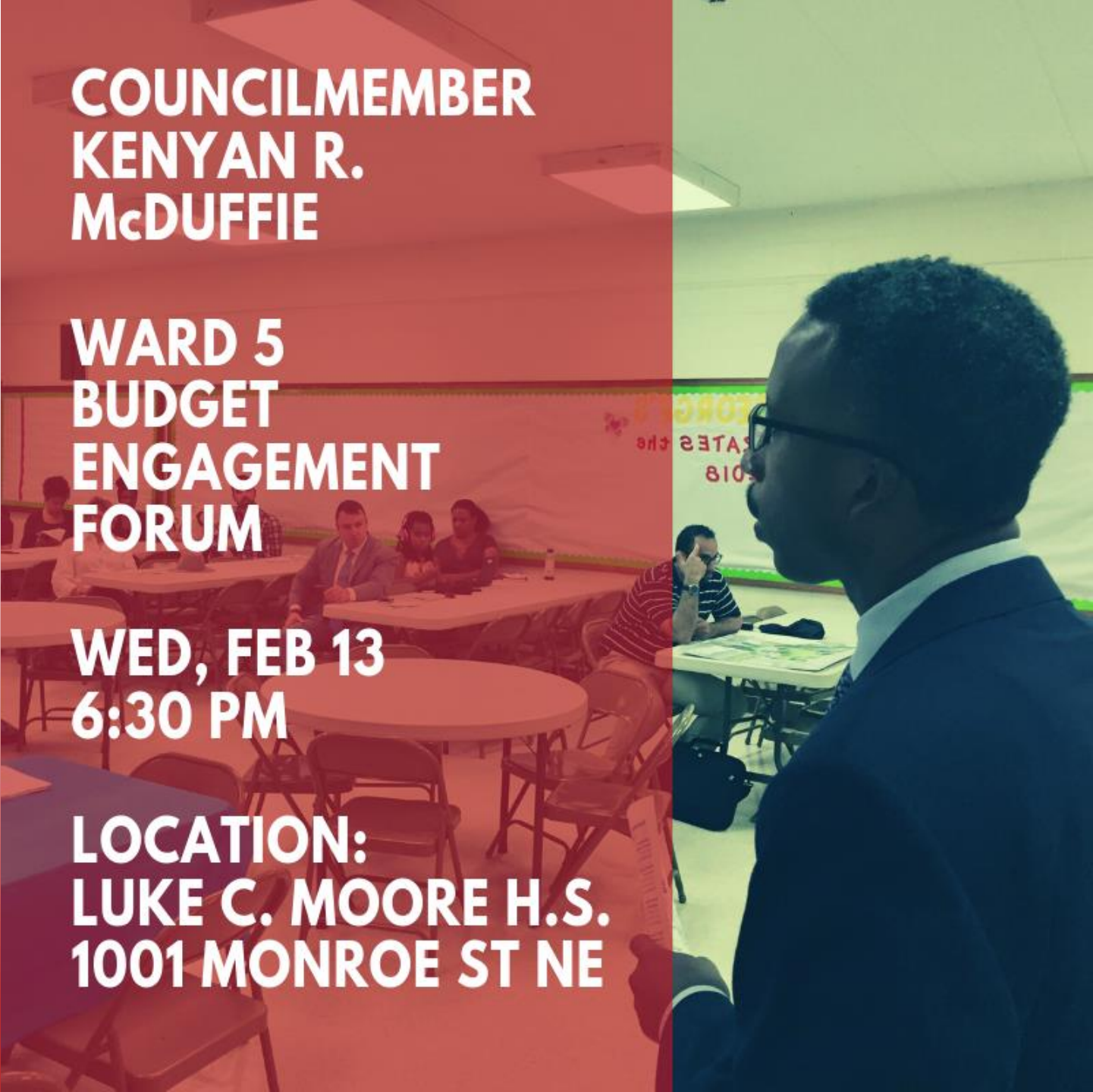

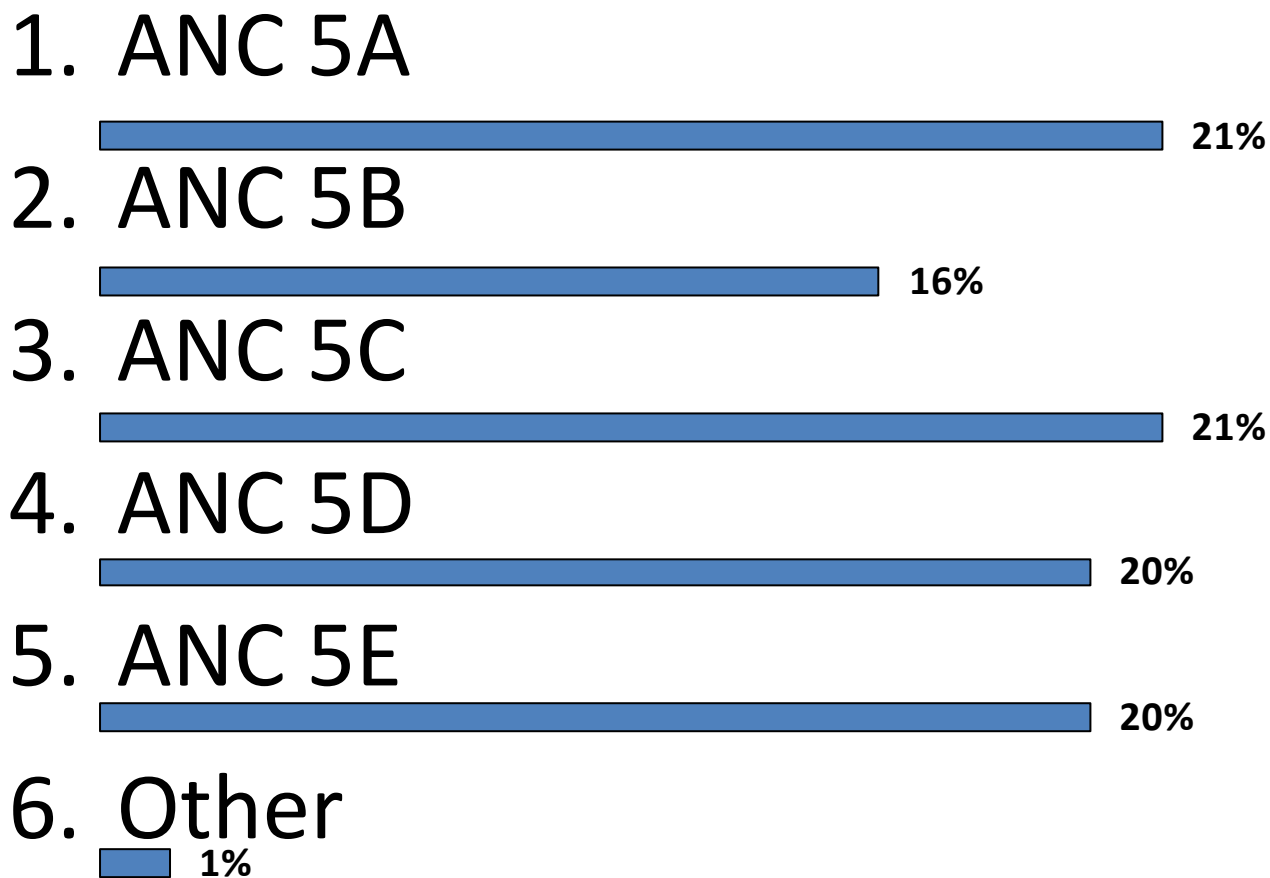

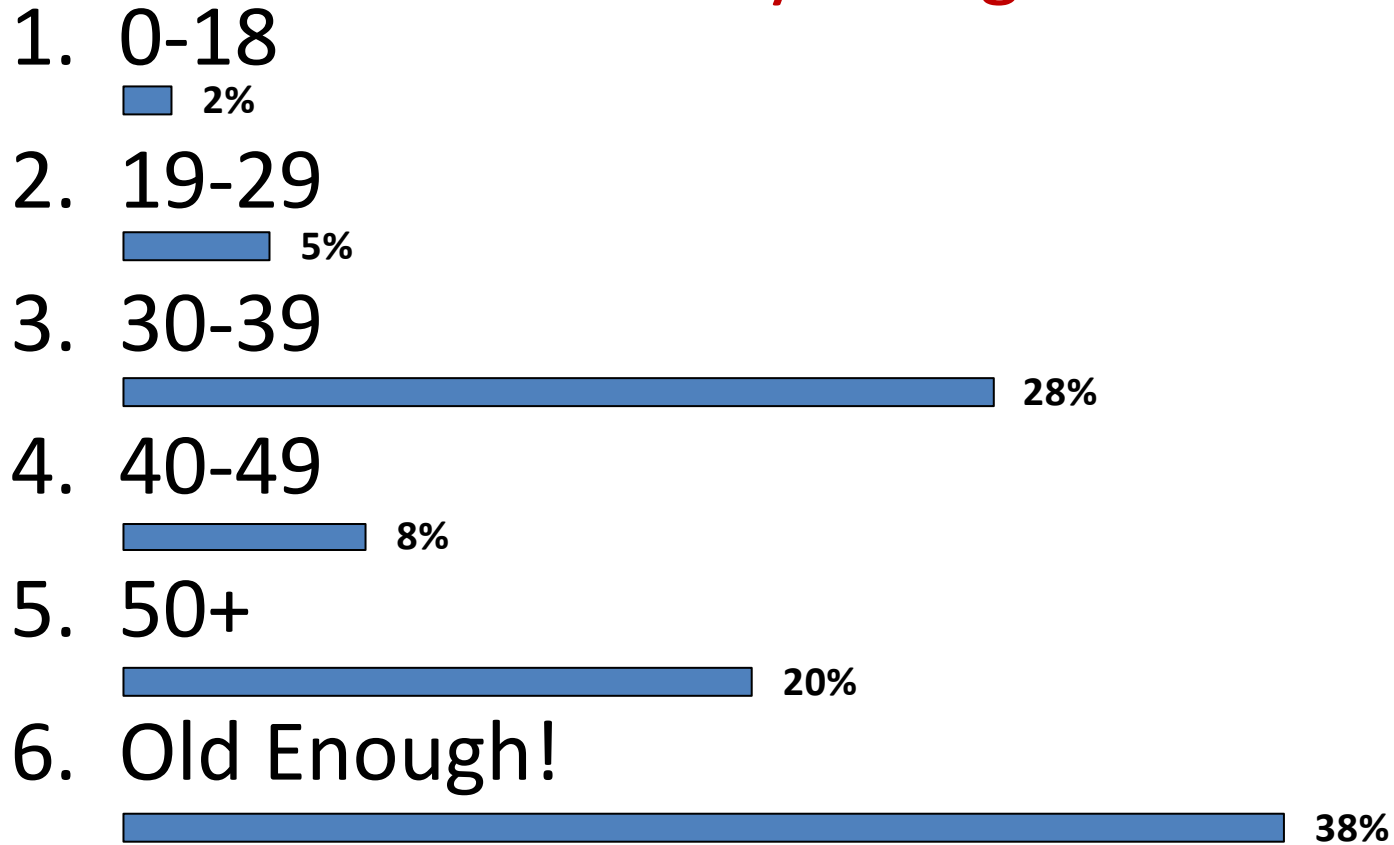
Demographic Information

Invested funds to study OB/GYN services in Ward 5 and the eastern portion of the District



Supported \$20 million in funding for a new Lamond-Riggs Library



Invested nearly \$500,000 in funding for new Main Streets and Clean Teams (South Dakota/Riggs Road and Bladensburg Ave)



Provided an additional \$200,000 in funding to support seniors and residents with disabilities through the Transport DC Program

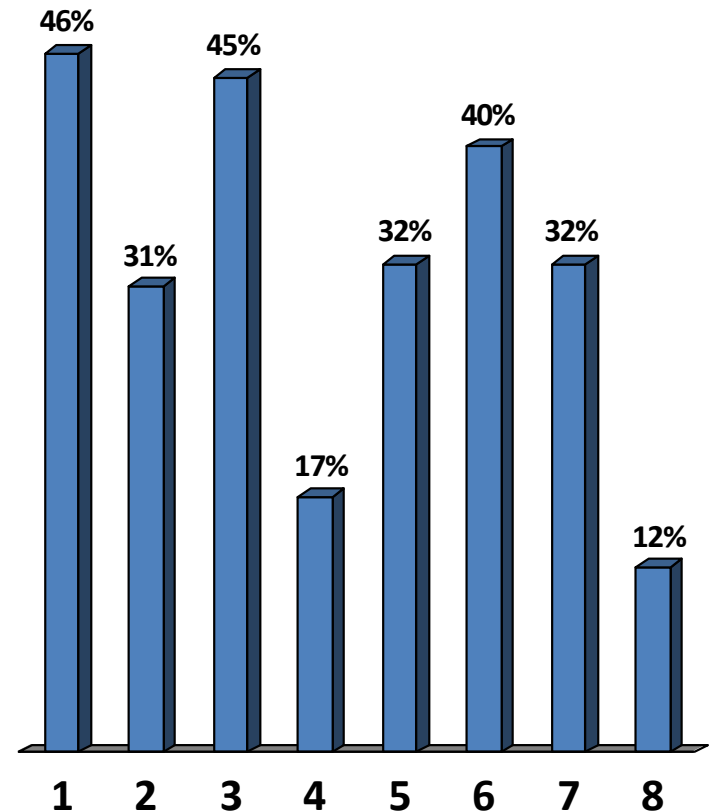


Secured an additional \$162,000 in rent subsidies for extremely-low income seniors
